

Front Doors

If you want to change the color of your front door when your street is scheduled to be painted, you must use one of the approved colors below. There is an extra charge of about \$35.00 charge (plus tax) that you will be responsible for. This charge may change from year to year.

The approved door colors are:

- SW 2040 (Tan)
- SW 2294 (Carriage Door) red/maroon
- SW 2049 (Window Box) dark brown
- SW 2272 (Barharbor) blue
- SW 2237 (Village Green) green
- SW 2126 (Tricorn) black

Garage Door colors are:

- Greystone Pt – SW Super Paint [Antiq.Parchment] Satin finish
- Weston Pt – SW Super Pain [Nacre] Satin finish
- Coopers Run – SW Super Pain [Nacre] Satin finish

Outside Wood

If you are repairing wood components (homeowners' responsibility) and replacing the cedar with cedar, then prime with a high-grade oil primer. If you are replacing the cedar with a plastic of some kind, then two coats of super paint are sufficient since it is a primer and paint in one.
