Front Doors

If you want to <u>change</u> the color of your front door when your street is scheduled to be painted, you must use one of the approved colors below. There is an extra charge of about \$35.00 charge (plus tax) that you will be responsible for. This charge may change from year to year.

The approved door colors are:

Outside Wood

If you are repairing wood components (homeowners' responsibility) and replacing the cedar with cedar, then prime with a high-grade oil primer. If you are replacing the cedar with a plastic of some kind, then two coats of super paint are sufficient since it is a primer and paint in one.
